COURSE DESCRIPTION

In this workshop, students will delve into human anatomy for artists by studying some incredible illustrations by renowned illustrators. During this workshop, the instructor will create one life-size copy of these illustrations, drawing on top of the different bones and muscle groups necessary for such detailed work. Students will work from live models and various handouts as references for drawing studies. This workshop will demonstrate how to study human anatomy, particularly in active and dynamic poses.

This intense and fun workshop is for all of the nerds who love drawing the human figure!

WHAT TO BRING

- Color pencils, Blue, Red, Purple, Yellow, Orange, Green. Any kind of brand would be good, get one of each.
- Graphite pencils, 2b and 6b, any kind of brand could be work. I recommend steadtler. Another options could be mechanical pencils, 2b leads and hubs leads. 003, 005 or 07 could work.
- Kneaded erasers. Recommend cretacolor.
- Pencils sharpener or box cutter.
- Sketchbook for notes, any kind of sketchbook the student is comfortable with
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
