COURSE DESCRIPTION

Using wax, students in this workshop will learn how to carve, sprue, invest, weigh, and cast in bronze and silver. This class will cover carving three-dimensionally in wax to create one-of-a-kind castings that can be used to fabricate jewelry or ornamental objects. Over the week, the students will learn the basics of lost wax casting and finishing, including sanding, filing, and sawing. Each student will leave with 2-3 cast pieces at the end of the week.
