## COURSE DESCRIPTION

A zine (pronounced ZEEN; short for magazine or fanzine) is a small-circulation self-published work of original or appropriated texts and images, typically reproduced via a copy machine. In this artist-led workshop, students will utilize photographic and hand-drawn techniques to create a self-published run of one or two-color screen-printed zines. The workshop will cover common genres in zine making including per-zines (personal zines), info-zines, fan zines, and comics. Workshop instruction will detail screen preparation for photo process printing, zine formatting, color separation, and editioning of prints. Students are encouraged to gather reference imagery ahead of the workshop. Examples from Alán's personal practice and zine collection will be provided as references.

## WHAT TO BRING

- 1 Apron
- 1 8oz Water Based Screen Printing Ink if different color from what the studio provides is desired. Please do not purchase fabric ink or Jacquard inks as they take longer to dry.
- 1 10-20 pk of 100lb card stock of your choice, studio will provide a light gray paper to print on
- 1 9x12 inch sketchbook
- 1 12 inch metal ruler (optional)
- 1 Writing utensil
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
