## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Have you always wanted to quilt, but have no idea where to start? In this workshop, students will dive into scrap bins and other source material to think through piecing and contrast while looking at the Log Cabin block and how it can keep inspiring us. Through smaller-scale blocks, students will learn the history of this block and how they can shake it up by adding or subtracting our guiding rules. Once students have made some samples, they will learn hand quilting techniques and get you quilting in no time!

## WHAT TO BRING

- Thimble
- 1-3 Old Garments or Nostalgic Textiles
- 3-4 Clothing items to be used as source material. It could be from your own collections or thrifted from local second-hand stores. It is highly recommended to bring wovens and natural fibers.
- 45mm Rotary Cutter (optional)
- 2 - 45mm Rotary Blades (optional)
- 24" Quilting Ruler
- Dressmakers Shears
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
