COURSE DESCRIPTION

In this workshop students will use hand building techniques to create small expressive sculptures of the natural world. Topics covered will include the breakdown of a form into parts, pinching, coiling, slabs, refiring, and attachment of multiple clay pieces. Themes will include narrative in sculpture and attention to surface and texture. This workshop will cover underglaze application in bisque firing techniques and discuss multiple glaze firings. At the end of the workshop, each participant will have created a small series of bisque fired and underglazed objects.
