COURSE DESCRIPTION

Woodturning is an immediate process that can result in a functional object in just a couple of hours. In this workshop, students will learn how to safely turn functional bowls and platters from both green and kiln-dried wood. Using only the bowl gouge, students will begin the process by shaping the outside of the bowl, and then prepare a reverse mounting method to turn the inside and reverse once more to trim the foot. In this workshop, emphasis will be on safety and technique, and form and function. Each student will leave this workshop with many bowls and platters, new technical skills, and the confidence to safely practice woodturning.

WHAT TO BRING

- Dust masks. I personally like the 3M 8511 masks found at any hardware or big box stores.
- Turning smock (can be expensive) or a large button up shirt
- Pair of comfortable safety glasses
- Pair of inexpensive and comfortable work gloves that you can cut the fingers off of. This will protect your hand from the shavings coming off the tool while turning.
- Pencils
- Note pad to take notes and draw in
- Any woodturning tools that you own and would like to learn how to use and/or sharpen
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
