COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop combines abstract and figurative art to explore movement and the human head through watercolor painting. Emphasizing color and form, this workshop integrates traditional and digital techniques, including photo manipulation and collage, to create modern, dynamic works. The course is designed to meet students where they are, offering a range of skills from basic to advanced. Students will cover materials, color theory, and contemporary approaches, all within a supportive and engaging studio environment.

WHAT TO BRING

- Plastic Water Container that can hold at least 2.5 quarts. BIG open mouth found at hardware store.
- Cotton towel, paper towels or large clean rag
- Spray bottle
- HB graphite pencil
- Ruler (metal with cork backing is ideal) (optional)
- Round tip watercolor brushes # 2, # 6, and #12 Synthetic (Student Grade) or Sable (Best) (optional)
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
