COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop will explore the various ways of forming pots using slabs, coils and simple bisque molds. Students will make their own tools and explore wax resist techniques using slip and glaze to form intricate and elaborate textures and designs. Students will leave with molds, tools, recipes, handouts and a variety of pots made throughout the workshop!

WHAT TO BRING

- 1 set of various watercolor brushes
- 1 Watercolor faux squirrel fan brush number 6
- 1 exacto knife
- 1-5 example pots like cups, bowl, plate that the student would like to copy
- 1 set of favorite tools
- 1 Mudtools white finishing sponge (or similar)
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
