COURSE DESCRIPTION

Lidded containers offer a mystery! What's inside? In this workshop students will create lidded boxes, lidded bowls and will work on tool skills, design and embellishments. Students will use a variety of woods and will create unusual knobs and finials as well as learning a variety of ways to take your work to the next level. Fun is guaranteed! This class is best for someone with at least some turning experience, and even an advanced turner will learn a few tricks!

WHAT TO BRING

- Any favorite turning tools or tools you are having trouble sharpening
- Anything fun or strange that might be used as a knob or finial on a box or bowl
- Any special pieces of wood to use to make a lidded container (optional)
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
