COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop will explore advanced wheel throwing techniques, including the use of a throwing stick. Once students have confidently created the complex form(s) they would like to decorate, students will experiment with sgraffito design techniques to take their objects to a new level. Sgraffito is a decorative technique that involves scratching away a surface layer to reveal a different colored layer underneath.

WHAT TO BRING

- 1 Basic pottery tool kit
- 1 Throwing stick
- 1 Calipers
- 1 Sgraffito tool
- 1 Mop brush
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
