## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop will investigate various wood-bending techniques to explore form and volume. Working with thin strips of wood, students will experiment with curved lines and organic forms by steaming, laminating, soaking, and weaving. Students are encouraged to push the limits of the material and explore its potential for expression. This focus of this workshop will be experimenting and playing with linear elements, resulting in forms ranging from maquettes to prototypes for future sculpture and design projects. This workshop will be valuable for both beginning and intermediate students.
