COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop will cover several techniques in hand papermaking including introduction to sheet forming, as well as methods to personalize work using stenciling, embedments, and transfer techniques; along with pulp painting and printing. A variety of fibers will be explored during this session as well as use of various additives to make beautiful and unique work in handmade paper. This workshop is designed for not only the beginning papermaker, but those with experience who want to explore further options in this medium.

WHAT TO BRING

- Scissors, Exacto Knife & replacement blades, metal ruler, pencils
- Plastic stencils if you have them
- Sharpie Markers
- Several yards (2-3) of heavyweight Pelon Interfacing (not iron on!). Found in fabric shops.
- Assorted fibers, yarns, dried plant materials. Ribbon or other desirable materials to use
- A few soft bamboo brushes in different sizes
- Rubber gloves, waterproof shoes, apron
- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
