Whether students work with vessels or sculpture, finding ways to make the surface of your work come alive can be a challenge. Students will be introduced to methods of applying texture, color, and composition to create more dynamic and interesting surfaces to their work. These methods will be useful to the beginner as well as more experienced students.
