## COURSE DESCRIPTION

In this workshop, students will build an old time open back banjo from start to finish. This workshop will cover neck shaping, fingerboard glue up, peghead profiling, inserting and dressing frets, truss rod adjustment, through dowel-stick assembly, as well as banjo pot construction and nut filing. Students will also gain the knowledge needed to set up, refine, maintain, and repair an instrument. Students will return home with a beautiful instrument to enjoy for years to come. All skill levels welcome.

- Dust mask, eye protection, ear protection
