A taste of woodturning offers students a chance to learn new skills, or knock the rust off of some old ones in a supportive, fun environment. This workshop will cover how to safely make utilitarian kitchen items (ex: utensil handle, candle stick, small bowl) with traditional tools and then students will play with some embellishment options using pyrography and paint.

- Flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)
