COURSE DESCRIPTION

In this workshop students will learn the fundamentals of fusing glass in this fun exploration of color and design. Open to all levels, students will explore both full and tack fusing techniques to add layers and dimension to finished pieces. For extra interest and detail, students will work with versatile glass elements such as frits, stringers, and rods. Students will make ornaments for any occasion imaginable—from a flower for a kitchen window to a candy corn for Halloween or a holiday gift. This workshop is a great way to learn about fusing glass, explore new skills, and express creativity. Students will each go home with multiple beautiful, unique pieces of glass art.
