## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop will cover basic drawing and painting techniques through observation, designed to enhance the ability to manipulate space and volume through detailed study. Students will focus on three main subjects: the human figure, still life, and outdoor landscape. Students will have the opportunity to draw the figure through both lengthy poses for in-depth study and shorter gestures for practice. The emphasis will be on drawing focused in naturalism, and individual styles will be encouraged during a lengthier figure painting project. Students will leave with a stronger technical foundation and increased confidence in translating complex subjects to a two-dimensional surface.
