COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop invites students to experiment with traditional dye techniques that use natural dyes, such as the indigo plant and the cochineal bug, to create vibrant hand-painted and printed patterns on fabric. After decorating cloth with their own personal touch, students will follow a simple sewing pattern to construct an innovative shirt out of their experimental fabric. Wearing clothing dyed with natural dyes can serve as a reminder that we are also a part of the natural world. Students will leave with a completed, uniquely dyed, and sewn garment.

- 8 Buttons for sewing onto shirt
