COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop explores intuitive art, a non-judgemental approach where creation is guided by intuition rather than a set pattern. Participants will make art quilts—layered and stitched creative visual works—using materials like fusible adhesive, cotton, and found embroidery. Students will begin by creating a technique sampler, practicing essential skills such as hand sewing, fused raw-edge appliqué, and hand embroidery stitches. While the focus is on hand-stitching (sewing machines will also be accessible), the course covers all steps, including finishing techniques like bindings and hanging sleeves. Daily slide talks, group discussions, and brief writing exercises will help students explore the idea of intuition and generate creative ideas, resulting in completed art quilts and a more expansive, confident approach to art making. Open to students of all skill levels.

WHAT TO BRING

- two yards white cotton cloth, prewashed
- found and gathered fabrics and embroidery: old tablecloths, teatowels, garments, etc. that you are willing to cut up, various pieces of cloth-about 2 yards total. Be sure to prewash them with no fabric softener. (There will also be a class stash that you are welcome to use if you don't have these materials to bring.)
- variety of embroidery threads and sewing threads
- embroidery needles and a thimble if you use one
- scissors: large (optional)
- scissors: small (optional)
- rotary cutter (optional)
- Pigma Micron pen size 01 and/or white chalk pencil
- pencil/paper (or sketchbook)
- flash drive (to protect and save data to and from Library computers)

MATERIALS FEES | **\$40.00-\$70.00**
