COURSE DESCRIPTION

This workshop offers a way to explore various woodworking techniques through the creation of a unique sculptural light fixture. Students will learn basic woodworking skills necessary in a typical woodshop, alongside very basic electrical wiring for a light source. This workshop will also cover specialized techniques such as bent lamination and coopering (a technique typically used in barrel making). By the end of the workshop, students will leave with a finished, functional piece of sculptural lighting that showcases their technical exploration.

WHAT TO BRING

- One LED lightbulb (that is compatible with an E-26 base) that excites them
- At least one image of something they have made (it does not have to be woodworking)
- Sketchbook and pencil
